

# **SKSA Team Reclassification Guidelines**

## **RECLASSIFYING SINGLE “A” TEAMS TO “AA”**

- Any Single “A” team finishing the previous fall or spring season with an 1125 or greater USSSA Power Rating will not be allowed to compete as a returning single “A” team.
- Teams that had an 1125 or greater USSSA Power Rating will be required to disband or be reclassified as a “AA” team.
- The SKSA baseball board will ensure these reclassification guidelines are enforced.
- Power Ratings will be recorded after the SKSA league regular season play to ensure post season tournaments to not skew the teams USSSA Power Ranking.

## **RECLASSIFYING “AA” TEAMS TO SINGLE “A”**

- SKSA will encourage any “AA” league team finishing the previous spring or fall season with a USSSA Power Rating of 500 or less to be reclassified as a Single “A” team.
- It is up to the discretion of the team manager as to whether to accept the recommendation.
- Any SKSA “AA” league team finishing with a USSSA 500 Power Rating or less that chooses to return to Single “A” will be allowed move as a full Friendship team.
